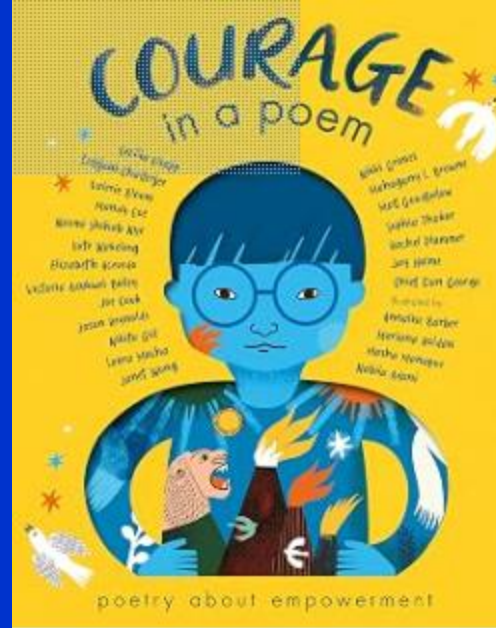
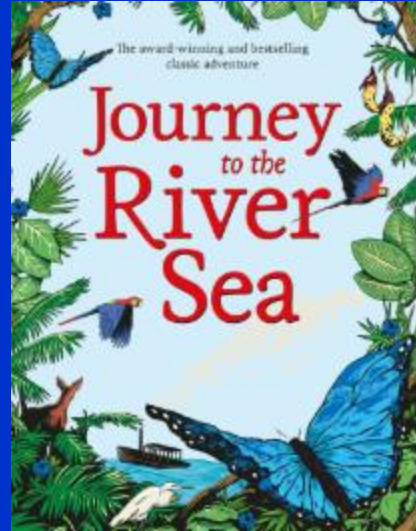
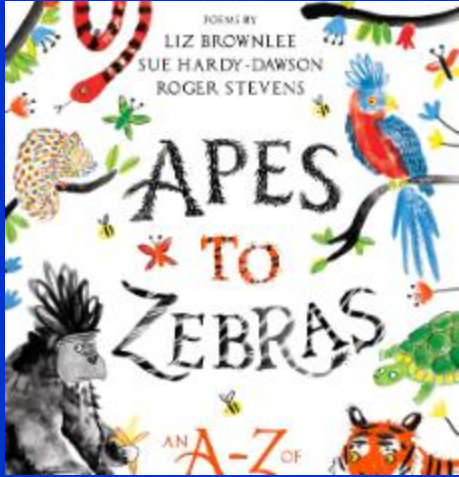

Accelerated Reader

At Riverview, children in Key Stage 2 use Accelerated Reader to help to motivate them to read more. It aims to widen vocabulary, improve children's reading age and promote reading for enjoyment.

Accelerated reader is a computer-based program that we use to monitor reading practice and progress. It helps children choose books that are on their reading level, yet still challenging.

Children are given a level, within which they can choose a variety of books that interest them. After reading a book the children will take a quiz to check their understanding. Progression through the levels will be determined by their quiz and reading test results.

Year 4 MTC

- **Year 4 National Government Test.**
- **The Year 4 Multiplication Test Check (MTC) is a short term assessment designed to check that children can recall their multiplication and division facts.**
- **Knowing their tables confidently is an important foundation for many areas of Maths- help build fluency and the ability to tackle more complex maths problems.**
- **8:15 is important- we start the day practicing our times tables.**
