### Welcome back

### Home learning activities

We will also start sending homework in the coming weeks. This will be done through Google classroom. Each Friday you child will be assigned an English, Math or topic homework to complete. Handwriting sheet will also be sent home for you to practice at home. Home work will need to be submitted back on the Google Classroom by the following Wednesday.

### Reminders

#### P.E.

The children will need to come to school in their full kit in school on **Mondays and Fridays** (We will not be changing in or out of our kits). They should have jogging bottoms and a t-shirt as well as plimsolls/trainers (they can wear their school jumper on top). If your child wears earrings please can you remove them on PE days. If we are unable to do P.E. on the allocated day due to bad weather, the session will be re-arranged for a different day that week and you will be advised by ParentMail before school that morning.

#### Equipment

Please ensure that all of your child's school equipment – Uniform, lunchbox, coat etc. is named. Please make sure that their reading book and reading record is in school every day – it will be checked during guided reading.
