



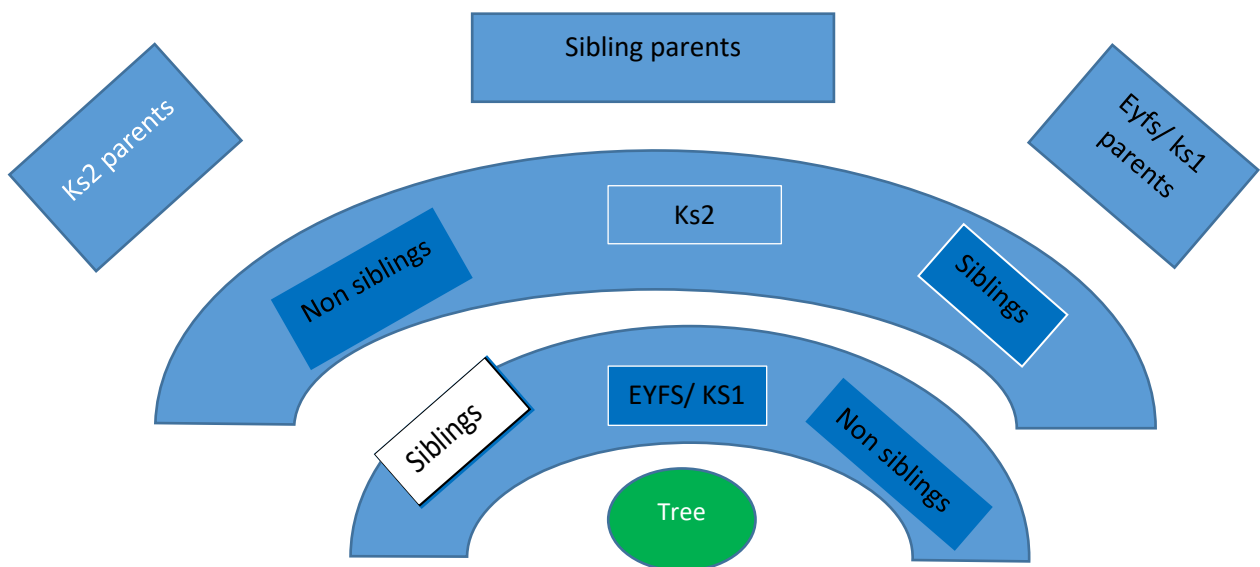
## CAROLS AROUND THE TREE

Dear Parents and Carers,

As a church school, Christmas is such an important time of year and even more so for the great community at Riverview. For the event to be successful, we have to ensure that it is safe. Please read the information below so that you know and understand the plans.

- Parents should **make their way to the field** using the one way system
- Parents will be **required to wear masks and use hand sanitiser** when they get to the field
- There will be **three pods for parents to stay in for the duration of the event**. This is to make home time easier and distanced.
- If **parents would like to sing, masks can be removed**. Parents must ensure that they are distanced from other parents. When singing, water droplets spread more so distancing is essential
- **Movement between the pods** and near the children is **not allowed**. I know that parents want to see their children but distancing and the arrangements for the event must be followed
